



Think-Pair-Share Career Assignment

By the end of this assignment, students should have the ability to:

- Identify a career pathway they are interested in pursuing.
- Understand the educational pathway and their corresponding occupations and wage potential.
- Understand how to utilize tools to learn more about specific industry jobs in our 7 county region as well as where to search for them.

Instructor Directions: Think-Pair-Share is a collaborative learning strategy where students work together to learn a concept or explore a class topic. Students will need to be paired with a classmate or small group to complete the following assignment.

Use the **Think-Pair-Share Template** to record your answers to this assignment.

Part One: Think (individual exercise)

Student Directions: Go to <u>EarnUp.org</u> and look under Career Pathways. There, you'll find a library of reports on our region's targeted and support industries. After reviewing all of the pathways, select a Career Pathway you find interesting. Then, think about, and answer, the following questions:

Part Two: Pair (small group discussion)

Meet with your assigned partner or small group to talk through your thoughts and ideas from Part One. Be prepared to share your responses with the whole class.

Part Three: Share (whole class discussion)

The instructor will expand "share" into a whole class discussion. Suggested discussion topics include:

- How does personality type or work style fit into the careers we've discussed today?
- Based on what we read and discovered on EarnUp.org, what skill do employers say people lack when applying for jobs?
- How do we prepare for a potential career? What next steps can we take as students?
 - o Ex: Volunteer or job shadowing opportunities, educational pathways, etc.
