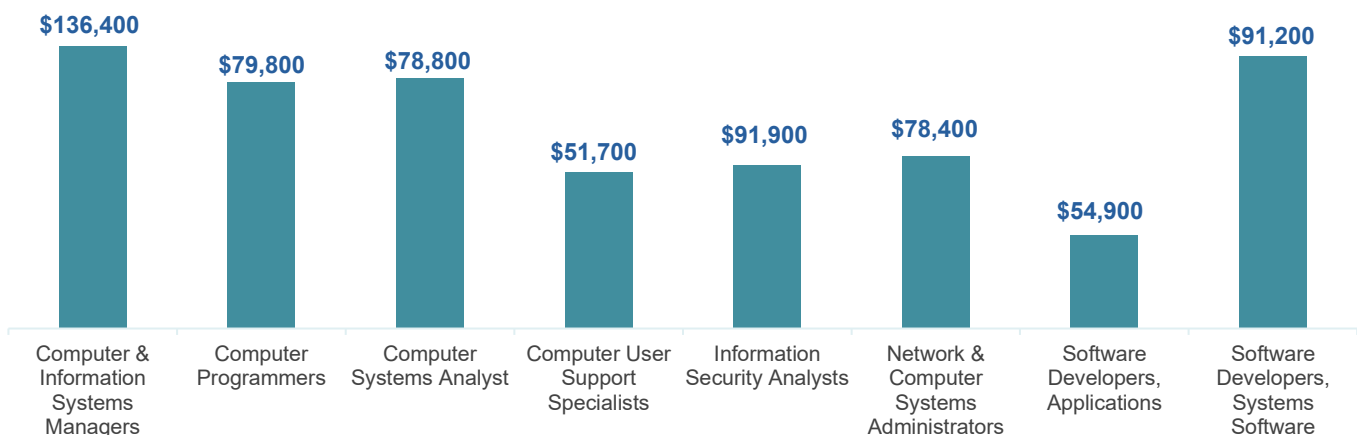
The occupations shown below represent a cross-section of entry-, mid- and executive-level positions within the industry.

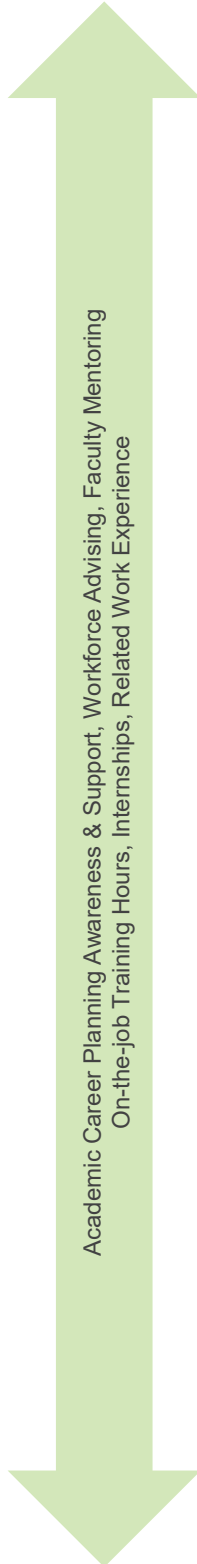
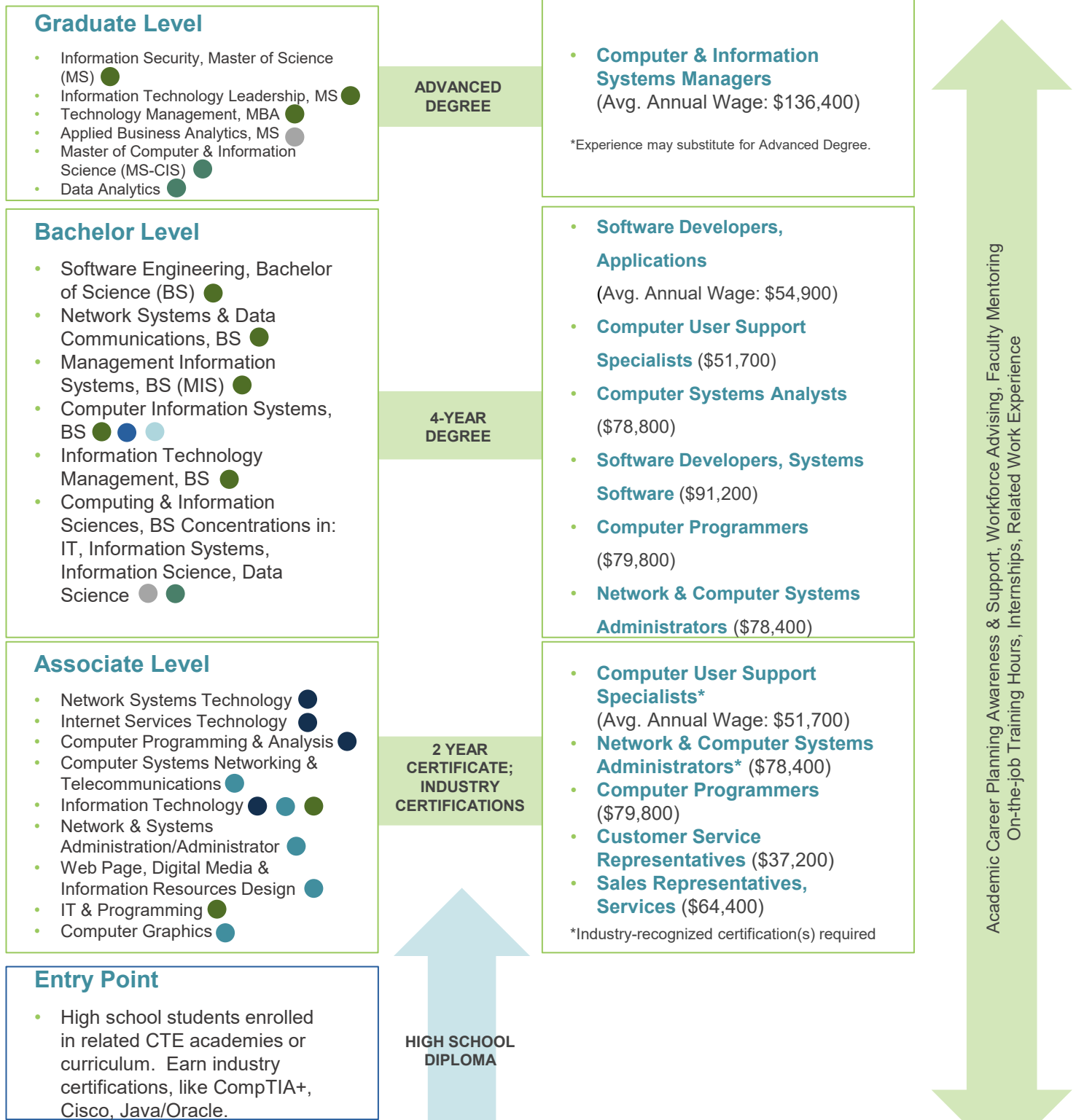
