Northeast Florida is America's Logistics Center--

We are one of the only centrally located East Coast regions offering all four pillars of logistics: rail, air, maritime and highway. This makes the seven-county region ideal for international trade, as well as logistics and supply chain management investments and employment.

Three major railroads—CSX, Norfolk Southern and Florida East Coast Railway—use Jacksonville as a railroad hub/interchange. Three major interstates—I-95, I-10 and I-75—connect the area with every part of the country, and Jacksonville's deep-water port has three public marine terminals.

Employment in the Logistics industry has been steadily rising this past decade with an average annual increase of 5%. According to bls.gov, Florida exports represented 3.3% of the U.S. export total in 2022. Jacksonville itself boasts a strong intermodal system with multiple cargo terminals at JAXPORT capable of handling container, automobile, bulk, bread bulk and refrigerated cargoes. CSX and Landstar are Fortune 500 companies headquartered in Jacksonville.


The occupations shown below represent a cross-section of entry-, mid- and -executive-level positions within the industry.
