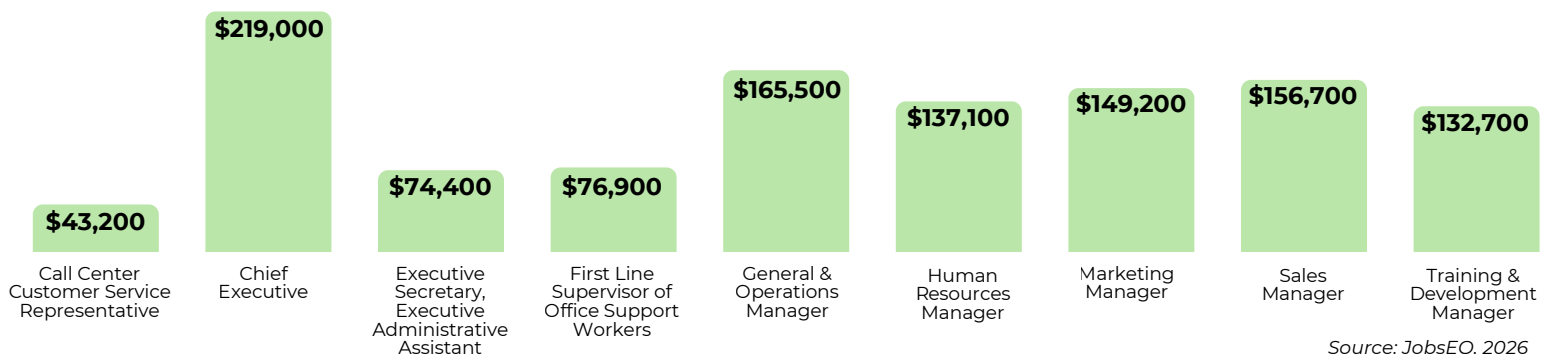
Jacksonville **Top 5 City** for Attracting College Graduates (*U.S. Census Bureau*)

BUSINESS IS BOOMING IN THE JACKSONVILLE REGION:

WINN-DIXIE COMMITS TO KEEP HQ IN JACKSONVILLE

Winn-Dixie reaffirmed its commitment to Jacksonville in 2026 with a \$65 million investment that will retain its corporate headquarters and support continued growth in the region.

The investment includes enhancements to the company's headquarters and local operations, reinforcing Jacksonville's role as the home of one of the nation's most recognizable grocery brands.

The project is expected to create 200 new high-wage corporate jobs while retaining more than 500 existing headquarters positions. The new jobs are expected to have an average annual wage of approximately \$100,000, strengthening Jacksonville's corporate operations talent base and creating new career opportunities for local professionals.

The announcement highlights Jacksonville's strength as a destination for corporate headquarters and business operations. With a skilled workforce, competitive business environment and deep roots in the community, the region continues to attract and retain companies looking to grow their corporate presence.
